



Curriculum Ordering Guide: A Resource for Schools

Suggested Placement by Grade, Recommended Materials, and Cost Estimator

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Overview

The following product and cost breakdown is provided to help schools get a sense of what they will need to implement Logic of English curriculum, as well as the approximate cost per student for initial and subsequent years.

As a general estimate, schools can expect the cost of implementing Logic of English to be approximately **\$60-\$100 per student** in an initial transition year, depending on grade and placement (including the cost of all reusable teacher and classroom materials as well as student consumables), and approximately **\$30-\$45 per student in subsequent years** (consumables only). **Prices are subject to change; for current pricing please visit <https://store.logicofenglish.com/>.**

This calculation includes curriculum for reading, phonics, spelling, grammar, vocabulary, basic composition, and handwriting instruction. Totals will vary by grade, by number of students per class, and by the curriculum placement the teachers determine is best for their students in each grade (such as whether or not handwriting instruction is needed, or how many levels of *Foundations* the class will cover in one year).

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SUGGESTED SCHEDULE 1

Schedule 1 is more gently paced and keeps the primary focus on reading through 2nd grade, teaching *Foundations* over the course of three years. Recommended if many incoming first and second grade students are weak in basic phonemic awareness, phonics, and decoding skills.

SUGGESTED SCHEDULE 2

Recommended if a high percentage of students are reading at or near grade level. Schedule 2 is slightly more accelerated, teaching *Foundations* over the course of two years and beginning to place a stronger focus on spelling and grammar, using *Essentials*, starting in 2nd grade.

TRANSITION YEAR, Option 1: Foundations A-B-start C	<p><i>In the first year implementing Logic of English, start first grade with Foundations A if students have not yet developed strong skills in segmenting and blending sounds and words, knowing all the sounds of the A-Z single-letter phonograms, reading unfamiliar CVC words, and handwriting the lowercase letters. If in doubt whether or not level A is necessary, use the A materials for a shorter review before starting B. In subsequent years, with students who used Foundations in Kindergarten, start with Foundations B if students did not complete that level, or with C after a review of B if they did (see Future Years, Options 1 and 2).</i></p> <p><i>If students have already developed the skills taught in Foundations A, see Transition Year, Option 2.</i></p>

If students have weak skills in one or more of these areas, consider starting in Foundations A, or completing a brief review of A, before starting level B (see Option 1, above).</i>

For this option, teachers will reuse the A-C teacher's manuals and all supplements but will need additional classroom materials for level D in the second year.</i></p> <p><i>If students did not finish the material in B in kindergarten or if teachers feel that a more extended review is needed for mastery, see Future Years: Option 1, above.</i></p>

Second Year: Foundations C (review/finish if students did not complete in first grade of transition year) and Foundations D All future years: Foundations D with unit studies and challenge activities.</p> <p><i>Second grade students who have not yet studied Logic of English may begin with either Foundations B or Essentials. Later, with students who completed Foundations B and C in 1st grade, Foundations D may be used in 2nd.</i></p> <p><i>The Foundations option is especially appropriate if a high percentage of incoming first and second grade students are still developing basic reading skills. Both Foundations and Essentials start at the beginning and systematically teach the phonograms and spelling rules, but Foundations moves at a slower pace in a more playful style and places a greater emphasis on the development of reading fluency. Level B teaches crucial phonics concepts needed for Levels C and D and must be taught before starting these levels of the curriculum, but teachers can expect to teach this level fairly quickly with second graders before spending most of the year on C and part of D.</i></p> <p><i>For Essentials, see Option 2, below.</i></p>

OPTION 2: Essentials	<p><i>Complete spelling, reading skills, phonics, vocabulary development, grammar, basic composition. May be used in conjunction with The Rhythm of Handwriting (see below).</i></p> <p><i>Second grade students who have not yet studied Logic of English may begin with either Foundations B or Essentials.</i></p> <p><i>The Essentials option is recommended if most incoming 2nd grade students are reading comfortably at or near grade level and are ready to focus more on spelling. Both Foundations and Essentials start at the beginning and systematically teach the phonograms and spelling rules, but Essentials moves at a faster pace in a more grown-up style and places a greater emphasis on the development of spelling mastery, while continuing to strengthen decoding and comprehension skills.</i></p> <p><i>Note: The Essentials Reader is designed primarily for older struggling readers and is not necessarily recommended for this level. Its themes, vocabulary, and sentence structure may be too challenging for some students in second grade.</i></p> <p><i>For Foundations, see Option 1, above.</i></p>

Supplement with The Rhythm of Handwriting (see below) if handwriting instruction is needed.</i></p> <p><i>Essentials may be taught to a variety of grades, or a variety of ability levels within one class. Lessons are designed so that teachers can teach the core content of the lesson to all students and then use the three levels of spelling lists, grammar activities, and vocabulary instruction to differentiate application and practice. A Placement Test is included to guide teachers in determining the best starting point for each student.</i></p> <p><i>The multi-level instruction within Essentials means that schools may introduce it in multiple grades simultaneously. Some older students already reading and spelling well will start with level C, but most elementary students will benefit from starting at level A or B and repeating the curriculum a second time at a higher level for deeper mastery, instruction in new concepts, and application of the concepts to new words. We recommend teaching Essentials in grades 2 or 3 up through the highest grade needing spelling instruction in the first two years of teaching Logic of English in your school. Eventually, once the school has transitioned and students are reaching fourth or fifth grade already having completed Essentials twice, explicit spelling instruction will no longer be needed in upper grades; teachers can simply teach and analyze new words from course reading, using and reinforcing the concepts students have learned in Essentials, as they go.</i></p> <p><i>The optional Essentials Reader, a high-interest, phonics-controlled reading comprehension supplement, is designed to meet the intellectual needs of struggling readers age eight or nine to adult. It is strongly recommended for any students using Essentials for reading remediation. It may also be used as a general reading comprehension program for 3rd or 4th grade if desired.</i></p>

Classroom Sets

The prices listed in this overview reflect the full price for each item (as of the date of this document; please see our webstore for current pricing). However, we also offer several types of discounted packages for schools.

Complete Classroom Starter Sets provide all the necessary teacher materials, student reusables, and one year's worth of student consumables for a given curriculum level for 20 students at a 10% discount. This option provides the greatest savings.

Consumable 20-packs are available for all consumables and are 10% off individual workbook prices.

Teachers Sets provide teacher-only materials for each curriculum. These discounted packages are a good option for those teaching fewer than 20 students.

4-Student Supplement Sets provide all needed reusable supplements for four students. These discounted packages are a good option for those teaching fewer than 20 students or adding to a Complete Classroom Set for classes of more than 20.

PDF Workbooks

Logic of English student consumables are also available as PDFs. The digital versions are recommended primarily for schools using the books digitally and those with both highly efficient printers and staff time allotted for printing. In many cases, printing costs exceed the price of printed workbooks, particularly with the full-color workbooks for *Foundations. Essentials* workbooks are over 300 pages, and *Foundations* workbooks are 200 to 300 pages.

PDF products come with the following licenses:

Single Teacher License - For use by only ONE teacher. Schools must purchase one license per teacher. No time limit.

The Single Teacher License is used on teacher materials.

Annual Classroom License: For use by only ONE teacher with his or her direct students. This limited reproduction license allows up to 40 copies and is valid for one school year, expiring on July 31st each year. Multiple teachers in the same school must each have their own purchased license. Annual Classroom Licenses can be renewed each year and are priced at five times the printed product cost.

The Annual Classroom License is used for student materials, including Readers and consumables.

Children’s Literature for Foundations D

One cost in teaching *Foundations D* is the children’s literature used in the program. These fiction books are a vital component of the program, because by this point in *Foundations* students have learned all the phonograms and spelling rules they need for decoding and can spend lots of time improving fluency and comprehension through reading! We have worked to select a variety of high-quality children’s literature, including beloved classics and some newer titles, to use in the program along with our original, nonfiction *Foundations D* Readers.

These books are available directly from Logic of English, individually or in a discounted set (\$75), as well as from a variety of booksellers.

You will need enough copies for every child to be able to use for reading practice. We recommend that schools concerned about cost purchase enough for children to use in one section or reading group at a time, or for partner reading, in the first year. You can then increase your set as you are able in future years.

Flexible Quantity Items
